What is workplace Giving?

Workplace giving is the process of making regular donations to charities through your employer's payroll system. Employers may choose to match employee donations or donate a specified amount.

Together, you and your employer can make a real difference in achieving our Vision which is to eliminate sudden and unexpected deaths during pregnancy, birth, infancy and childhood, together with the provision of quality services that reduce the impact of the death of an infant or young child.

How does it work ?

Workplace giving is a simple, tax effective and cost efficient way to donate to SIDS and Kids ACT. Donations are made from pre-tax pay, which is reduced by the amount of the donation – meaning that the tax deduction is immediate and guaranteed.

There is no need to collect, keep and claim receipts – it couldn't be easier! So a \$20 donation pre tax costs the donor only \$13.70 after the automatic tax deduction, but SIDS and Kids receives the full \$20.
